

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTION


PRO AS180 comes with a power cord cable (packed separately).




2 Unfasten the top cover screw.




3 Open the top cover.




4 Remove the back cover screw.



5 Remove the back cover by **pushing it up**.





6 Insert the power cord to the unit's plug point.



For Installation On the Wall


- Fix 2 pieces 4mm diameter self-taping screws onto the wall with 79mm apart.
- Phook the unit to the self-taping screws on the wall, plug in and power up.






For Standalone unit on the floor


1 After Step 6, align the power cord cable with the edge as circled below.




2 Slot in the back cover, align the power cable to enable the cable to exit from the slot of back casing.



4 Close the top cover.





5 Fasten top cover screw.
Plug in to the electrical outlet and power it up.




To Select Various Modes

1 Unfasten the top cover screw.









To Service/Clean the unit's module


- **1** Repeat Step 1-5 (page 1-3)
- 2 Remove the power plug.



Remove the 2 screws at the bottom back plate.




4 Tilt the bottom back plate.




Brush the module by using a clean tooth brush to clean the surface from dirt.

If the module is very dirty, greasy or sticky, it is recommended to use Autosol to clean it.

Then, use a damp cloth to clean the residual and wipe dry before installing back.




Fasten the screws of the bottom back plate. Insert the power cable, back casing and plug in back to power plug.




To Service / Clean the Unit's Filter

1 Remove 4 screws at the back plate.




2 Pull out the top part of back plate.




Remove the filter's top housing using flat screw driver at the slot provided.

Take out the filter and wash. Dry it after wash.



Put the filter back and reinstall the filter's top housing.



6 Insert the top part of back plate to the main housing.
